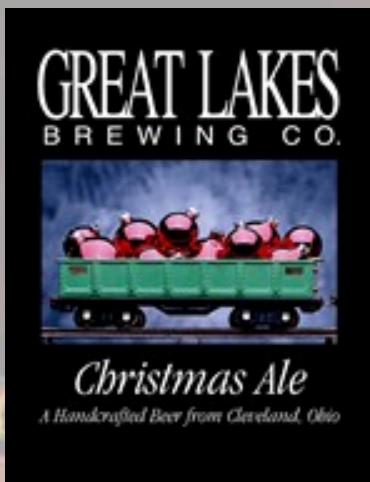

## Chianti

*Chianti is Italy's most famous red wine, which takes its name from a region in Tuscany where it is produced. It used to be identified by its squat bottle enclosed in straw, however this package is used by very few producers now. "Chianti Classico" is from a smaller, specific region within Chianti and "Riserva" denotes a higher quality aged Chianti wine*

These wines are bold and full bodied.*

## Puglia

*Puglia, which spans Italy's long stiletto from northwest to southeast, rivals Sicily for being the largest producer of Italian wine, although most is considered "bulk" wine, the region is becoming increasingly popular for premium wine*

A cousin of American Zinfandel. Soft tannins, good acidity and the soft mouth feel

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## Sicilia

*Sicily, an island off the south coast of Italy, is one of the most productive wine regions. Although a substantial proportion of the output is use for food production.*

**Nero D'avola, Il Maniero** 8 28  
Ripe, dark cherry and plum fruit and soft oak overtones

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## Emilia-Romagna

*The strongly individual characteristics of this region make them northern Italy's most eccentric. They are different, on the whole, from the wines of their neighbors, so the Sangiovese here will be more subtle.*

**Sangiovese di Romagna Riserva, Umberto Cesari** 8 28  
This wine is dry, ample, rich and well balanced

**Lambrusco, Riunite** 6 (By the glass only)  
The flagship wine of this region, this version is slightly sweet and served chilled

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## Piemonte

*Piemonte wine is the range of Italian wines made in the region of Piedmont in northwestern corner of Italy. The Nebbiolo grape is the most predominant grape in the region which makes Gattinara, Barbaresco, and Barolo wines, each named for their respective regions. Barbera and Dolcetto grapes also account for a significant portion of the area's wine production.*

**Barbera d'Alba, Viberti** 30  
Earthy black cherry fruit, concentrated yet elegant with soft tannins

**Gattinara, Tenuta Santa Raffaele** 45  
Intense dark color along with violet bouquet plus hints of anis, vanilla and spice

**Barbaresco, Salvano 1999** 50  
Dense, concentrated flavors of sweet red fruit, roses, and tar, firm finish

**Borolo, Viberti, Buon Padre** 60  
Medium bodied, round tannins, complex with plum, leather, and smoke

**Borolo, Cannubi, Casina Adelaide** 65  
Outstanding single vineyard wine, velvety tannins, rich ripe fruit, toasted oak

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## Veneto

*The Veneto, named after the most famous city in its region, Venice, is the leader in regional Italian wine production, the majority of which is white wine. The top reds are the famous Amarone and Vino di Ripasso, affectionately referred to as a "baby amarone"*

**Vino di Ripasso, "Mara", Franco Cesari** 32  
Flavors of ripe fruit, preserves and cherries, full bodied but well balanced

**Amarone Classico, Cesari** 69  
Currant, tobacco and mineral flavors; medium bodied with firm tannins
